

Hanging Instructions for 6-panel Multi-canvas Paintings

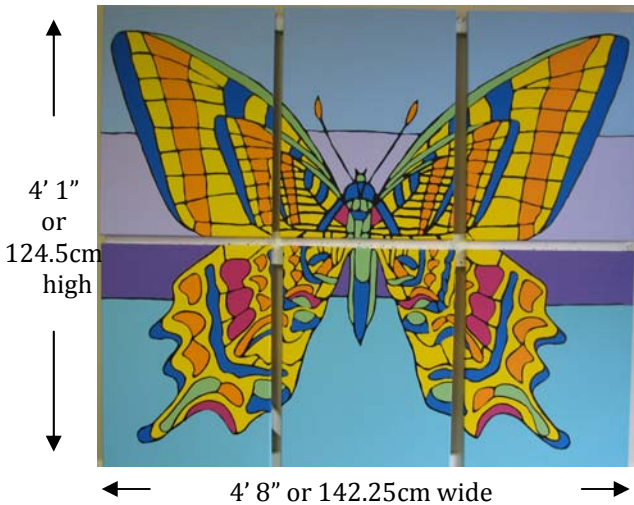
We encourage you to hang these paintings in patient treatment areas (i.e., radiation rooms, physical therapy areas, patient rooms, patient hallways, and waiting rooms).

The paintings are designed to be hung with **1" - one inch (2.5cm)** between each canvas. The one inch space eliminates the need for framing.

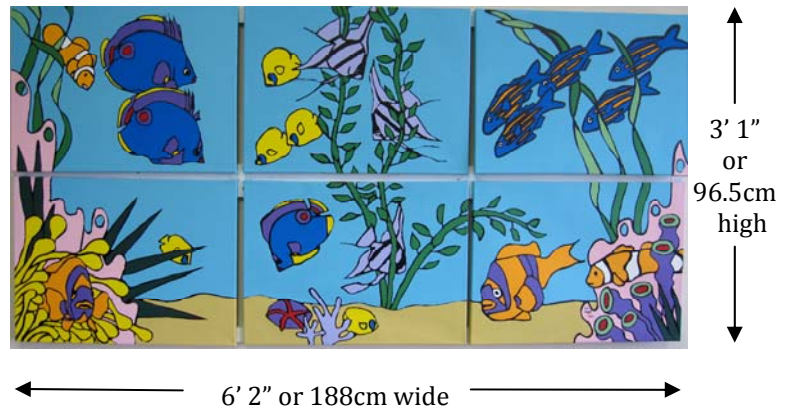
Though most designs require all six canvases, there are some designs that can be broken up into individual pieces for smaller spaces. Each canvas is coded on the back (top right) with a number. You have three canvases on top (1, 2 & 3) and three on the bottom (4,5 & 6). Each canvas is 18" (45.75cm) x 24" (61cm). The canvases form either a "Vertical" or a "Horizontal" format.

Every facility has different procedures for hanging pictures. You may use nails (two per canvas, 12 total), double-sided tape, or other hanging techniques to secure the paintings. Recommend use of a level.

Vertical Painting Layout

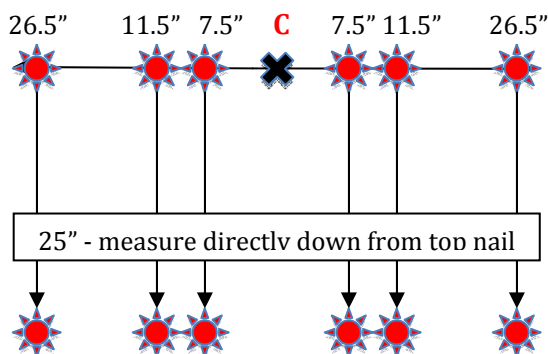


Horizontal Painting Layout
